Shane Smith's fielder's choice scored Saunders for a 9-2 Nicholas County lead.

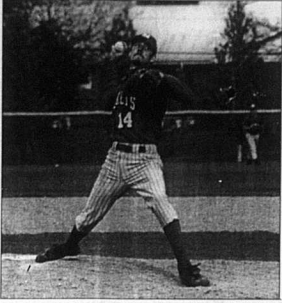
Smith sat a pair of Panthers down on strikes in the second and Fryman flipped to the lanky pitcher covering first for the other out.
