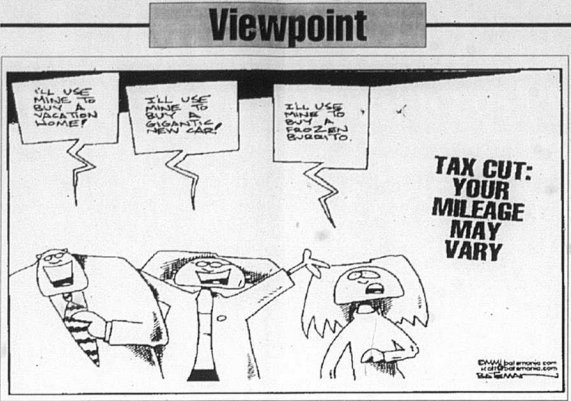
Even the president of the Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences compared his style to the rebelling of "21st, the Stones and the Beatles."
