

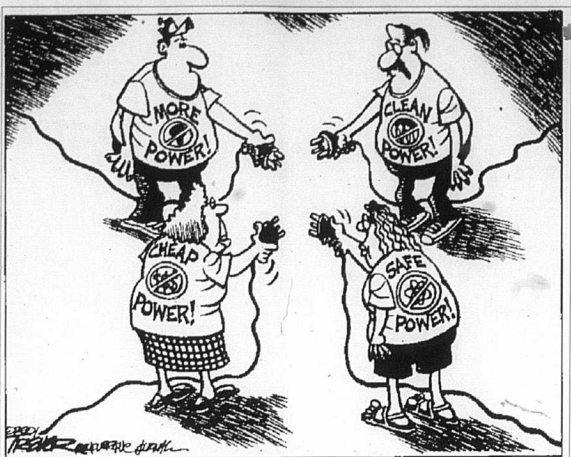

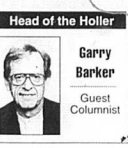

Department of Parks is supporting the concept of a 300 acre recreational lake in its front door.

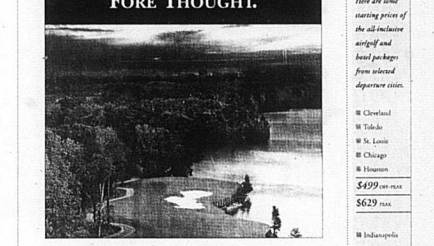
