The movie opens in a train station with Prot just appearing and then attempting to help a lady...

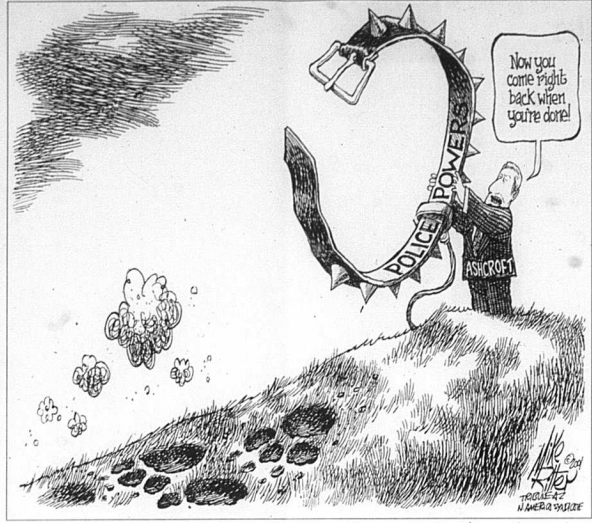
Upon questioning, it is revealed that Prot (Spence) claims to be from another planet...
