AN ORDINANCE LEVYNG CITY OF CRAILSLE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY, 1200 THROUGH JURY 20, 2022 ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIR THE TAXING JURISDICTION OF THE CITY ON EACH ONE HUNDRIDG 1500 00) DOLLARS OF JANUARY 1, 2001
