Kentucky gets tougher on boating safety

FRANKPORT - People who operate a boat while intoxicated will face tougher penalties under a new Kentucky law. House Bill 453, which now has passed both chambers of the state General Assembly and is on its way to the governor for his signature, is a timed at improving the safety of Kentucky's rivers afterly of Kentucky's rivers afterly of Kentucky's rivers.

The bill doubles all fines for operating a boat while under

operating a boat while under the influence of alcohol. When the new law goes into effect in July, the fine will be \$200 for first offense, \$350 for a second offense, and \$600 for all subsequent offenses. The bill requires that

anyone convicted of boating while intoxicated must attend a boating safety class and pay a \$100 fee for that class.
