That hot hand has belonged to Bretz lately. He put in a pair of late-inning innings to knock off the Black Devils last week on his way to team-best 29 points.



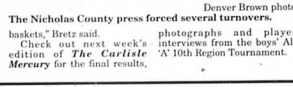

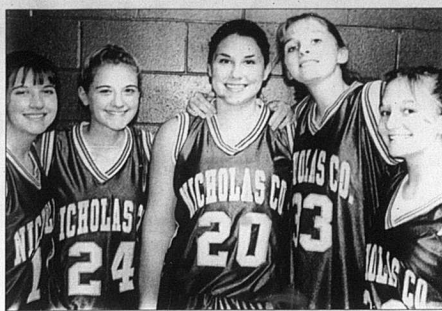

Poll shows voters support cigarette tax increase

A new, independent statewide poll shows broad support in Kentucky for a 75-cent excise tax increase on cigarettes.

The poll was commissioned by the Kentucky Health Investment for Kids (or KHIK), a coalition dedicated to reducing youth smoking in the Commonwealth.

The survey was conducted by QEV Analysis, a Washington, D.C.-based independent public opinion research firm, and carries a margin of error of plus or minus 4.1 percent at least the 95 percent confidence level.

The survey sample was weighted so that the distribution of age and sex precisely matched known characteristics of Kentucky voters.

Beyond support for the excise tax, those surveyed also expressed concern about the severity of the youth smoking problem in Kentucky.

The American Heart Association of Kentucky and another KHIK spokesperson said this is encouraging to the coalition.

As the state discusses an excise tax hike, Cindy Adams, Kentucky Advocacy Director for the American Cancer Society, said this survey result alone provides important information.

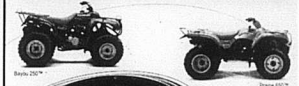
