## Women shouldn't ignore signs of heart disease

Although often thought of as a "man's disease," coronary artery disease is the leading cause of death of women in the United States. More than twice as many women die from heart disease than men, according to the American Heart Association. Despite the reduction in the overall death rate from heart disease in the past several decades, studies show the decline is less for women than for men and less for African American women than white women.

### Fleming-Mason Energy to conduct line inspections

Fleming-Mason Energy has begun the annual aerial line inspections. The inspections will take place in Lewis, Fleming, and Rowan counties. The inspections will take several weeks to complete.

The cooperative will use a low-flying helicopter to look for broken insulators, damaged or missing hardware, and power lines damaged wires, low clearances, trees in power lines, and any potential hazard involving Fleming-Mason Lines. These inspections are required by the Public Service Commission, and are necessary for Fleming-Mason to maintain the system.

### Unemployment rates drop in March

The trade sector had the second largest increase with 3,800 more jobs in March. Employment gains in this sector were in eating and drinking establishments (+2,500), department stores (+900), building materials and garden supply stores (+300), and automotive dealers (+100). From March 2001 to March 2002, the trade sector added 4,100 positions in retail trade establishments.

The services sector had the second highest gain with 3,400 new jobs in March. Job growth occurred in nearly all of the sector's industries including business services (+1,400), health services (+700), amusement and recreational services (+400), social services and agricultural services (+200 each), and hotels and other lodging places (+100), Craggart said.

The construction sector added 1,900 jobs in March as contractors in special trade categories rose by 900 jobs. March construction increased by 700 positions and general building construction recorded 300 more jobs in March.

Kentucky's unemployment rate fell from a revised 6.1 percent in February to a preliminary 5.6 percent in March, according to the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis.
