## PERMANENT RAINS DELAY PLANTING

Wet weather this spring has delayed corn planting in the Midwest. In the Carolinas, as of May 12, 55 percent of the corn crop is estimated to be planted, compared to 92 percent last year and the five-year average of 72 percent, according to the Kentucky Agricultural Statistics Service. Some early corn planters have very little corn planted, while others have managed to get a majority of their crop in the ground, noted James Herbek, a University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service agronomist.

In Daviess County, producer Mack Estes has been unable to plant any of his planned 1,000-acre corn crop. He has applied some nitrogen and herbicides, but rains constantly hamper his efforts to get into the field.

The spring has been frustrating, Estes said. He said he is out of time trying to get a good corn crop this year's planting season.

"I don't know what I'll do for sure, but I know I will likely plant less corn than I had planned," he said.

The prime planting window to obtain an optimum yield in corn is essentially closed and the remaining corn acreage will be planted after mid-May then yields will begin to drop, Herbek said. Historically, research has shown that a yield loss of 1 percent per day after the corn planted after the optimum period.

**Kentucky gas prices decline slightly**

Kentucky's gas prices have declined slightly and there should not be a major price hike going into the Memorial Day weekend, according to AAA Blue Book Kentucky. During the holiday an expected increase in demand could push prices into the \$1.50 range by the fourth of July and then prices should decline down again as summer ends.

The average price for a gallon of self-serve unleaded regular in Hawaii at \$1.07, Columbia at \$1.62, Alaska at \$1.56, and the District of Columbia at \$1.54. The lowest average prices are in Georgia at \$1.24, Oklahoma at \$1.26, and Missouri at \$1.27.

Motorists will probably face some volatility at the gas pump for the third straight summer as instability in Venezuela and the Middle East could be a factor in higher prices.
