Warm weather marks beginning of severe storms

The onset of warmer weather is a welcome sight after the winter, but it also marks the beginning of rain and storm season - a major public health concern. The Kentucky Department for Public Health (DPH) wants residents of the Commonwealth to be mindful of possible health threats brought on by storm season and how to avoid illness, injury and food contamination during the warmer months.

Remember that mosquitoes are most active during the warm weather. Wash fruits and vegetables with water from a safe source before eating. For infants, if possible, use prepared, canned baby formula that requires no water and use bottled water for concentrated or powdered formula.
