allow the potatoes to boil until they are still a little hard but where a fork will go into them easily. Once your potatoes are partially cooked you will lightly butter a 2- quart casserole dish. In a large bowl, combine potatoes, salt, sour cream, green onions, and Cheddar or American cheese. Cover the potatoes with the ingredients in the dish pour the melted butter over top of potatoes. Finally bake the dish at 425° for 25 minutes, or until potato casserole is nicely browned.

Ingredients: 6 potatoes, partially cooked, diced; 1 1/2 teaspoons salt; 1 cup sour cream; 1 bunch green onions (6 to 8), chopped; 1 cup shredded Cheddar or American Cheese; 1/4 cup melted butter.

Directions: Begin by preheating your oven to 425° then you will want to dice the potatoes into a small size so that they will cook evenly. You will cover them with cool water and place them on high heat.
