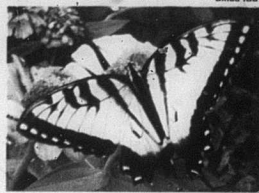

 ing Tuney apply for a credit  
 card and allowing Tuney the  
 use of her credit card to es-  
 tablish an EBay account.  
 "She had permission; she  
 had consent. She is not  
 guilty of theft of identifica-  
 tion," Griffiths said in clos-  
 ing arguments.  
 Wright focused on the  
 physical evidence in the case  
 and pointed out discrepan-  
 cies in post office box appli-  
 cations forms where Tuney  
 had used personal informa-  
 tion from Esterhazy to open  
 a post office box for herself  
 in Millersburg.  
 Esterhazy said she did not  
 know of that post office box's  
 existence.  
 Judge McGinnis halted  
 Wright's prosecution at one  
 point late in the trial when  
 Wright played what was  
 later described as the audio  
 tape of the grand jury tes-  
 timony, which Graves and  
 Tuney both testified before  
 on June 18 of this year.  
 The tape was of extremely  
 poor quality and sounded as  
 if the interviews were being  
 conducted along I-75 during  
 rush hour as the microphone  
 was being "voiled in circles."  
 "Can you understand  
 that?" Judge McGinnis  
 asked the jury after the  
 garbled tape played for five  
 minutes.  
 "No," the jurors said in  
 unison.  
 Wright adjusted the tape  
 recording device on the  
 court's microphones, and  
 though the quality of the  
 sound was improved, many  
 jurors grimaced while they  
 tried to decipher what was  
 being said.  
 McGinnis ordered the tape  
 stopped a second time.  
 Air conditioning in the  
 courtroom was used spar-  
 ingly as the noise of the cool-  
 ing systems masked the tes-  
 timony and questions during  
 the trial, and the heat inside  
 the sweltering room was a  
 force to be reckoned with.  
 "Everyone stand up,"  
 Judge McGinnis instructed  
 the jurors who were drifting  
 off as the tape was stopped  
 a second time. As the ju-  
 rors stretched and yawned  
 Wright promised the tape  
 was almost concluded. The  
 tape was then played again  
 and McGinnis reminded the  
 jurors that they could re-  
 quest to listen to the tape  
 in the cool atmosphere of  
 the deliberation room when  
 all of the testimony and evi-  
 dence was concluded.  
 Tuney appeared very re-  
 lax and spoke often with  
 Griffiths and co-counsel  
 Jennifer Wittmeyer.  
 "She was trying to get  
 credit and the only way she  
 could get credit was to say  
 she was Sara Esterhazy,"  
 Wright said during clos-  
 ing arguments. "I'm asking  
 you to return a verdict of  
 guilty."  
 The jury returned a guilty  
 verdict after deliberating  
 approximately 65 minutes.  
 "I'm extremely pleased  
 and satisfied with the deci-  
 sion the jury made. They did  
 what was asked of them,"  
 Detective Graves said Mon-  
 day. "They were very atten-  
 tive and listened to all of the  
 evidence."
