Shirk said he and his group have been welcomed very warmly in Nicholas County. "We have a good youth group and they are hard workers who like to help out," he said. "Mission projects teach the youth members to give of themselves," Toy added with a pleasant smile. "This is a group of good workers."

The youth group members will work through Thursday evening and enjoy fellowship together Friday at several local landmarks before returning to Ohio.

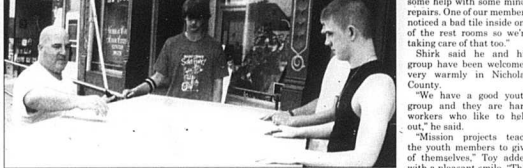

## Guild member honors memory of aunt

One of the many intricate banners displayed around Carlisle was painted by "one of the newest members of the Courthouse Square Arts Guild, Amiee Howson Hughes. "The banner was the first thing I've ever painted," Amiee said.

"I was so honored when she gave me this quilt," Hughes said as she gently moved her fingers across the center of the quilt as she admired it on the counter of her Massage Therapy and Wellness Studio at 140 East Main Street, Monday.

"The message of the quilt is that the universe is so much bigger than us and that there are replicating patterns in all of life, sort of like what comes around goes around, and radiating in the middle of everything is the sun, which makes everything grow."

"My aunt used different designs with each quilt and this one had a strong Celtic influence, but all of her quilts were special and she was recognized across the country for her talent with making quilts."

"Carol Power, one of the members of the Arts Guild, helped me out a lot, and painting the banner was a way for me to honor my aunt Jeanie Howson Sexton. She passed away last fall and I wanted to honor her memory."

"Amiee's banner was painted with much the same design of a quilt pattern made by her late aunt. "That quilt design is called 'I Am Woman; Heart of the Universe' and was made by Sexton in 1993. Sexton later gave the quilt to Hughes."

"The Arts Guild is very active and they do so many things to support the community. I'm very pleased to have been part of the project with the quilt banners."

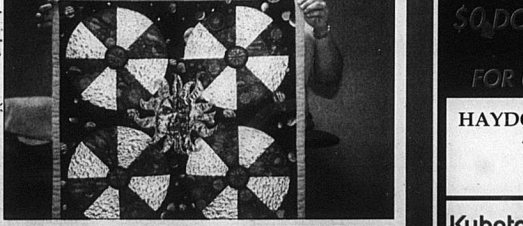
