One Patient's Story

I came from a family that had a lot of problems in their life. My dad was an alcoholic. When he was drinking he would physically and verbally abuse us when we were growing up through the years. I thought that this was normal and I must have done something wrong. For 23 years I had this in my mind and I must have done something wrong. As a child I began to overeat and started withdrawing. I wanted nothing to do with life. At the age of 23 I tried to kill myself. I'd just all hope until two years ago when I came to Stoner Creek where they started to work with me. They gave me the tools I needed to get on with my life. One of the tools was life size—I made me think about my life and after 23 years I finally got some back. I'm now 38—I walk 7 miles a day and I've lost 245 lbs. Thank you all at Stoner Creek.

Stoner Creek Behavioral Health Centre at Bourbon Community Hospital treats each patient as a unique individual having the care right to meet a personal program of individualized, evidence-based psychiatric care. This results in a quality approach utilizing the services of a dedicated team of psychiatrists, clinical psychologists, nurses, social workers, mental health technicians, recreation therapists and Kentucky certified teachers.

The Centre offers both adult and adolescent psychiatric inpatient programs. Stoner Creek Behavioral Health Centre can help adults 18 and over with behavioral, mental health or chemical dependency issues. The Adolescent Inpatient program, ages 10 - 17, can help children who are experiencing suicidal thoughts, severe depression, anxiety, psychosis, substance abuse and other emotional or behavioral difficulties. If inpatient admission is recommended, 24-hour services can be processed twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

Stoner Creek is renowned for their services to its patients, treating patients in need from 45 counties in Kentucky during 2006. Admissions to one unit grew by 12% in 2006.
