### Supporting Our Physicians

### Delivering High Quality Patient Care

Excellence and quality in patient care means everything to us. We are accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations for success in patient care by the comments from our past patients. According to Data Management & Research, Inc., overall satisfaction at Bourbon Community Hospital ranks in the top 15% of hospital's nationwide. Emergency Department satisfaction ranks in the top 7% of EP's nationwide with average wait times of less than two hours - this is less than half of the national average.

We have a 100% RN nursing staff in our patient care units and 100% of our Emergency and Critical Care Nurses are certified in Trauma and Advanced Cardiac Life Support. We participate in the nationwide Core Measures program sponsored by the Joint Commission and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The goal of this program is to assure that patients receive a standard quality of care regardless of which hospital they choose.

Our patient care is family centered care, but it is more than that. Our care is personal because it comes from genuine concern. After all, our patients are also our friends, family and neighbors—we truly believe we are neighbors helping neighbors.

### Providing Community Value

In 2006, we employed over 200 individuals and our payroll exceeded \$9 million. We paid over \$380,000 in state and local taxes and gave over \$14,000 in direct charitable contributions. We wrote off revenues of \$3.6 million in providing care to patients who met poverty guidelines or an additional \$74,409 in other uncompensated care.

The hospital participates in local school fairs, readiest programs, the community baby shower, the American Cancer Society Relay for Life and Healthy Kids Day. The hospital also sponsors the Toys for Tots Program in Bourbon County and our employees give service to many other local organizations including Junior Achievement, Kiwanis, Rotary and The United Way.
