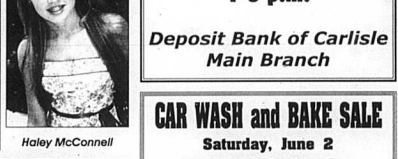
Porter named to U.S. Academy
