Third quarter run lifts Bath, 41-19

OWINGSVILLE — Nicholas County's season mark ended at 5-5 with a 41-19 loss at the hands of Bath County.

Nicholas County took the opening kickoff from their own 20 and marched to the Bath County 20 before turning the ball over on downs, facing fourth and four.

Brandon Clemens scored quickly on a three-yard run as the Wildcats drove down the field on five plays giving Bath County a 6-0 lead.

Coty Conway tucked on the extra point kick to make it 7-0, midway through the first quarter.

"The Jackets" Jonathan Mattox returned the kickoff from the five to the 25, and then after a five yard run by Shane Sweet, Mattox ripped off a 20 yard gain and then five yards up the middle and Mattox picked up three and a run to the Bath County 33 ended with a fumble and the Wildcats were back in business on offense.

It took the Wildcats less than two minutes to score as Clemens carried from 31 yards east around right end and Conway nailed the point to give Bath County a 14-0 advantage with a minute remaining in the first quarter.

The Bluejackets began their third offensive drive from their own 13.

Mattox carried for eight yards on first down, and Sweet picked up five and a first down as the quarter ended.

Nicholas County moved to the 35 on runs by Mattox. On second and 11 at the 34, quarterback Jordan Myner, back from a knee injury, looked down the left sideline and connected with Michael Ford for 31 yards and a first down at the Wildcats' 35.

Brandon Tedder carried for seven yards on first down, and a Mattox carry of five yards earned the Jackets another first down.

Sweet carried for three yards on first down at the Bath County 23. Jeremiah Brown picked up a tough five yards up the middle and Mattox picked up a yard to make it fourth and inches.

The call went to Sweet who plowed his way ahead for eight yards setting up the Jackets with a first and goal at the six.

Sweet carried for a yard straight ahead and on second and goal from the five, Mattox carried the "middle" of the Bath County line into the end zone to count the touchdown. Andy McCarty added the extra point and it was 14-7.

The scoring wasn't over for Bath County as the Wildcat tackled on a third first half score when Zach Metz scored from the four and Conway added the point after to set the halftime margin at 21-7.

In the third quarter Clemens tackled on two more touchdowns as Bath County scored three times in the period to extend the Wildcats' lead to 41-7.

In the second half Nicholas County scored twice, both times in the fourth quarter.

Brandon Tedder carried for seven yards on first down, but the point after kick was no good.

With 2:01 to go in the game, Anthony Kiskaden gathered in a Bath County punt his way through the Wildcats' special teams ranging to the end zone 75 yards away.

The point after attempt failed and the final margin was set.

"All in all, I feel like our lines won the battle. We held them to no passing yards," and NCIS Head Coach Hobbs Hopkins.

"We needed to get them on the ropes and we're not doing that. We played well, but there are things we

must work on," Hopkins says concerning the loss. "We are our own worst enemies."

Hopkins is proud of his team's 5-5 season mark, and "We've made the playoffs. We've been committed all season long. I am proud of the effort."

Looking ahead to Thursday night the Jackets face Lexington Christian Academy.

"Our best friend is controlling the clock," Hopkins is happy with the support of his team this season.

"We would like to thank the people who have come to our games. They have showed great support, along with all of the boosters and donations. There have been lots of people follow us this season."

Kickoff for the Class A playoff game in Lexington is scheduled 7 p.m.
