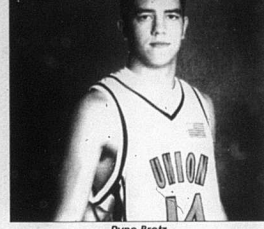

Bretz leads Union scorers

MCKENZIE, Tenn. - Behind 22 points and six rebounds by NCHS graduate Ryno Bretz, Union College erased a 12-point deficit in the second half against Bethel (Tenn.) College Saturday night, as the Bulldogs fought back only to fall short as Bethel hung on for the 75-71 victory.

The game was a part of the Bethel College Classic, Union (2-1 overall) trailed early, but the Bulldogs were in front, 32-31 at the half-time break.

Bethel (2-0 overall) regained the lead early in the final half and built the 12-point advantage over Union.

The Bulldogs battled back to cut into the Bethel lead and make the margin four points with 20 seconds left. However the Wildcats knocked down key free throws to hold on for the win.

Bretz (22 points and six rebounds) led all scorers with his 22 and he grabbed a team-high six rebounds. Brian French poured in a team-high 18 points for Bethel and Hrvoje Devic added 12 off the bench.

Both teams attempted 53 shots, however Bethel made 28 compared to Union's 25. Bethel also went 8-for-18 behind the three-point line while Union was 6-for-19.

The Bulldogs held the advantage at the free-throw line, 15-for-23, as Bethel collected one more rebound, 27-to-26, than Union and Bethel forced 25 Bulldog turnovers.

In the tournament opener, Bretz knocked down 11 points in the game as Union College hit 68 percent of its shots in the second half in holding off University of Rio Grande (Ohio) in a 79-76 tilt Friday at the Bethel (Tenn.)

FRANKFORT - Hunters required to report their harvests through the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife's Telecheck Service can review their reports online for accuracy now and even see others' reported successes.

The Telecheck Review made its debut on the Department's website, by gov. Monday, Nov. 5, just in time for the upcoming 2007 statewide modern firearms deer season opener on Saturday, November 10. It allows deer, elk and turkey hunters to review their harvest records.

Telecheck Review is an improvement on the best system we've ever had for monitoring our deer herd," said Department of Fish and Wildlife Commissioner Dr. Jon Gassett.

"Kentucky hunters have been using Telecheck's telephone keypad to report their deer harvest since 1998. After their report, they sometimes wonder if they keyed in the correct data. Now they can simply go to our website, click on the Telecheck Review link and check for themselves."

The service allows a hunter to check the accuracy of his or her reported data, which includes hunter's name, species and gender, harvest date, county and date

taken, type of weapon used and whether there were visible antlers or a beard.

If an error is detected, he or she can call the department toll free at 1-800-858-1548 and correct the entry.

When Telecheck made its 1998 debut, hunter harvest and game management took giant leaps forward. "We left a pencil and carbon paper system behind and stepped into the computer age," said Gassett. "The old check cards filled up by store clerks and others were often incomplete, inaccurate, and/or unreadable, and it took several months to physically go through the state and collect them."

Telecheck instantly improved the accuracy of our harvest data. Our law enforcement officers have an electronic database and carbon paper system behind their fingertips and know instantly if a hunter is compliant with harvest check-in requirements.

"Telecheck Review is going to make our Telecheck system even better," said Gassett. "The management and enforcement of our deer, elk and turkey populations continue to ex-
