Nicholas County health care auxiliary and volunteer program enters 30th year

In April 1977, Ken Urago, the Nicholas County Health Administrator at the time, called Ginny Kingsolver and asked her to start a hospital auxiliary and volunteer program.

The first meeting was held on May 23 with 66 charter members and 116 by the end of 1978.

Under Kingsolver's direction, and with the assistance of many dedicated volunteers and community leaders, the hospital auxiliary and volunteer program has grown to encompass the entire county.

In Dec. 1977 bonds were sold to finance a new hospital and the groundbreaking ceremony was held in early April of that same year.

Over the years the auxiliary has donated over \$62,000 worth of equipment and improvements to the Johnson-Mathers Health Care facility. These donations include a stereo machine that cost \$10,700 as well as land-scaping material and other needed technology and equipment.
