Roger Perley of the Scott County Sheriff's Office said Monday afternoon. Perley is the lead detective in the case and has received assistance from local officers with the SCSD, particularly Detective Jack Patrick and agents with ATF and officers with the Kentucky State Police. Perley made several statements of "no comment" when asked about specifics of the crime including what weapons were found at one location, perhaps more that may be connected to the murders. Perley also offered "no comment" when asked about allegations that Gray confessed to the murders.

Gray was also quick to point out that Gray had cooperated fully with the police investigation and during Gray's arraignment asked Judge Vanessa Dickson to consider lowering Gray's bond from \$500,000 cash to \$50,000 cash. Judge Dickson passed before noting two EPO violations on Gray in 2007, and an assault fourth charge against Gray in 2007.
