RACELAND - Nicholas County's Jonathan Mattox scored runs of one year and 33 yards to account for all of the Bluejackets' points, but it wasn't enough as Raceland used a 22-0 halftime lead to claim a 29-12 win.

The first quarter was a deadlock at 0-0, as both teams worked to find their niche and feel their way into the game.

Cornett settling in as NCHS girls' head basketball coach

New Nicholas County High School girls' basketball coach Jennifer Cornett had the opportunity to get very acquainted with her team last week.

Nicholas County finished the 2006-07 season 9-18. The Lady Jackets finished runner-up in the 38th District, falling to Harrison County in the district title game, after upending Pendleton County in the opener.

Nicholas County ended last season with a loss to Bishop Brossart in the 10th Region Tournament. Cornett is in the early stages of her first stint as a head coach.

"One of the scores came from blown assignments. Looking at the total yards, we had 330 yards and Raceland had 205."

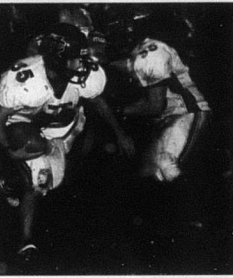
"We were down 29-0 at the half, not playing that bad and we came out in the second half and we shut them in."
