April 21, 1983

Citing five cases of hepatitis, one case of histoplasmosis and one case of typhoid "possibly" having been caused by the malfunctioning septic tank and no sewer line situated on Carlisle's East End, the grant application for new sewer and water was signed and sent to HUD last week for funds to build a new system. The grant application totals \$786,000 and was signed by Carlisle Mayor Frankie Hughes. If approved, the project would help provide sewer lines for 100 households and water for approximately 113.

The much anticipated liquor election is over with one side of Main Street voting for alcohol sales and one side voting against alcohol sales.

For now, Nicholas County has three "wet" precincts. They are Myers, City Building and Mathias and a total of three liquor licenses can be issued in the county according to population. Officials say each precinct will receive one license.

Michelle Rawlings and Dawn Curran have been

named to the 1982-83 Central Kentucky Girls Basketball Conference Team.

A petition requesting that the charge for telephone service be lowered 70 cents was presented to the local plant last week by subscribers residing on Moorefield Road. The petition was signed by 22 subscribers, every party except one between Carlisle and Moorefield. The petition stated that unless the charge was reduced the telephones of 176 subscribers would be discontinued on May 1. The monthly charge for these telephones 70 party line service ranges from \$1.75 to \$2.75 per month.
