Testing will begin at 10:30 a.m.

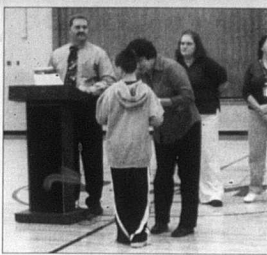
"Pay will be \$10.75 an hour," said Donna Lucas of the Census Bureau. "Plus our employees receive mileage reimbursement."
