

Lady Jackets hear the roar of Lady Lions, Wildcats

The Lady Jackets traveled to Lewis County on Tuesday, Feb. 5, and fell to the Lewis County Lady Lions 74-52. Shelby Sooby started off strong but began to struggle. While the weather was brewing outside into a major storm, Lewis was a sleeping giant in the first half. The Lady Jackets dominated the first quarter when Hollee Bretz started the girls off with six points, while Brandi Messick followed up with five more. With 4:06 left in the quarter Nicholas was up 12-7. At

the end of the quarter it was 20-14, with the Lady Jackets still on top, keyed by Jessica Gilkerson's 20 points. The Jackets continued with the lead in the second quarter, ahead 24-22 with 4:43 to play until intermission. Jessica Gilkerson made a three-point rainmaker that made it 27-24, with 3:26 to go in the quarter. Nicholas County's girls continued to work hard to the end of the quarter, and took a two-point, 33-31, lead into the locker room. The Lady Jackets came back from the half and played slugfest, but kept fighting to keep the lead. With 6:44 to go in the quarter, the Lady Lions tied the score 35-35. Shelby Sooby kept working with 9 points in the quarter, but the Jackets began to lose their intensity in the third quarter and started to fall to the grooves of the Lions. During the fourth quarter the Lady Jackets struggled, and the Lady Jackets let the game get away from them, falling by 22 points. The Lady Jackets only scored six points in the fourth quarter of the game. Shelby Sooby had 13 points, Brandi Messick contributed with two points, Hollee Bretz followed with four, while Hannah Dixon contributed with two points. The girls are scheduled to hit the road again, tonight (Feb. 13) to Paris to face the always tough rival Paris Lady Greyhounds.

The duties of this position include: processing and routing applications, preparing and reviewing applications, and maintaining files. The position is full-time, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The position is located in the Bourbon/Nicholas County FSA office, 400 West Main Street, Paris, KY 40362.

1. All applicants must be a U.S. citizen.
2. Be a High School Graduate or have GED.
3. Have 18 months of office experience.
4. Be at least 18 years of age, or 17 years of age for High School Graduate.
5. Have high school or college transcripts.
6. You may submit an FSA-475 (Application for FSA County Employment, Resume, or any other written format). You must include your SSN, your county of Citizenship, education, and work experience.
7. Supplemental FSA statements responding to evaluation criteria (other to vacancy announcement).

This job will be a permanent full-time position. Salary will depend on the experience of the person selected, but not less than \$20,500 per year. The employee will earn vacation and sick leave at the rate of 1 hour per 2 week pay period. Selected applicant will be eligible for fringe benefits including health insurance, life insurance, retirement and other benefits available to federal employees.
