Lady Jackets, Jackets seasons end in district tournaments



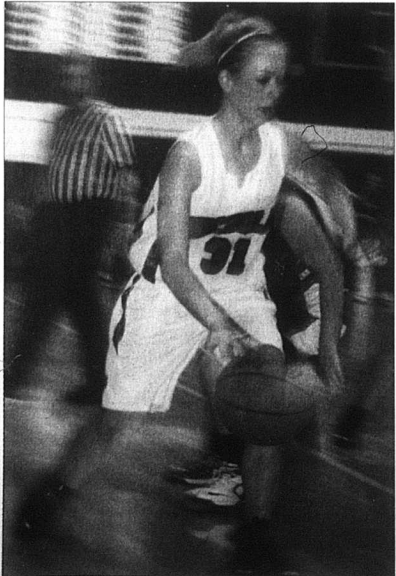
