Some say that Cornstalk's curse is still haunting the land.

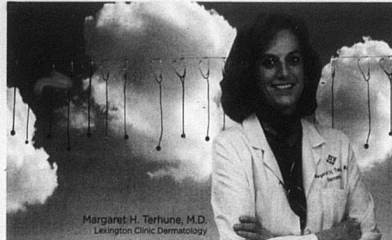

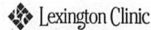
