Lady Jackets make ready for All-A

Fresh off a frustrating loss to district-rival Deming, the Nicholas County Lady Jackets enter All 'A' Classic 10th Region Tournament action this week looking for redemption.

But it will not be easy for the Lady Jackets, who face region-foe Bracken County in first-round action Thursday at 6 p.m. at Paris High School in Bourbon County. Bracken County enters the tournament with a 6-8 record, that includes two wins against regional opponents. The Lady Bears average 47 points per game while allowing 52 per night.

By comparison, Nicholas County enters with a 6-8 record overall that includes a 4-4 mark against regional opponents. The Lady Jackets enter the tournament averaging 46 points per game while allowing 53 per contest.

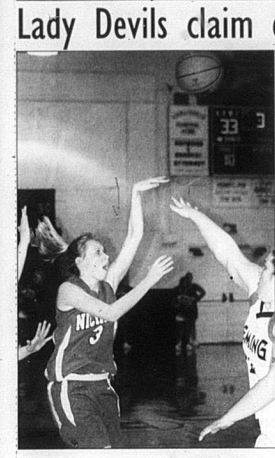

Turning in one of their worst performances of the season, the Nicholas County Lady Jackets suffered a 67-45 loss to Deming on Sunday in a game that left first-year coach Jennifer Corbett scratching her head looking for answers.

Whether her team was tired from playing four tough games in eight days after a long Christmas lay-off, or whether it had to do with playing the unusually scheduled Sunday afternoon game, Corbett wasn't sure exactly what the problem was. "But she knows it was major as her team lost by 22 points to a team it had beat earlier in the season."

"We are a whole lot better than this," said frustrated Corbett after the game. "But we come into games with the mindset that we are going to come in and beat them, but we don't get prepared to play. I don't know what our problem is, if we are physically tired or mentally tired or what. But we're not coming into games prepared."

Deming shot the lights out at times during the game, while Nicholas County was wild and could barely hit the rim at times, racking their shots and missing many second- and third-chance opportunities in the paint.

"It has to do with the way they practice," Corbett said of her team's slopping shooting. "They don't practice

giving better against the three than Nicholas County did. But Nicholas County comes into the game with some momentum on its side knowing that it beat Bracken County, 42-36, a year ago in its last meeting before this one.

"If you take away our last two games, I would think we are prepared for the All 'A' and for Bracken County," she said. "But considering the last two games, it's hard to say. You just never know with this team because we are so mentally inferior."

Nicholas County's last two games include a 46-40 win over Model where the Lady Jackets faltered down the stretch, and a 67-45 loss to Deming on Sunday in a game where the Lady Jackets turned in one of their worst performances of the season.
