

Livestock Health Requirements

All livestock/ animals offered for sale or exhibition at Kentucky County Fairs shall meet the following regulations according to KRS Chapter 257:

- 302 KAR 20.040 (Entry into Kentucky)
 - 302 KAR 20.065 (Sale and exhibition of Kentucky origin livestock)

Nicholas County 4-H/FFA and Open Youth Livestock Shows 2008

- All exhibitors are responsible for abiding by current Kentucky Livestock Show and Exhibition Requirements (302 KAR 20.040 and 302 KAR 20.065). - 4-H/FFA members are eligible to compete in Open Youth Show.
- 4-H/FFA members must be in good standing according to Nicholas County 4-H/FFA Youth Livestock Program Rules in order to show.
- All breeding stock must be registered by June 1 of the current year by the name of the exhibitor or family. Registration papers which are pending will be accepted if accompanied by correspondence from the breed association stating classes.
- No exhibitor will exhibit more than two animals per class.
- Where only one animal is exhibited in a class, first prize, if merited, will be awarded.
- Market classes will be divided day of the show and determined by weight (not breed).
- All other situations not mentioned are at the discretion of the show committee.
