2. 18" Draw Bar
3. Hook Point Must Be Stationary
4. No Turn Buckles
5. 18.4 Tire Limit
6. No Tire Chains or Duals
7. No Cut Tires
8. One chain must be tight, no jerking or bouncing. Must remain in seat at all times. Wheelie bars are preferred, but not required.
9. If front wheels get higher than 30" off the ground while pulling, judges have the right to disqualify if they deem necessary, without wheelie bars.
10. Two attempts at ten feet on same end of sled.
11. All winning tractors will be reweighed.
12. Must be 16 years of age or older.
13. 20 second time limit.
