A Brief History of Nicholas County

Few areas of similar size within the United States can claim an equal wealth of history as that which has been endowed upon Nicholas County.

A study of the history of Nicholas County should begin with its first inhabitants, a hardy group of people known today simply as the paleo peoples.

Although it is not known exactly when the first paleo hunters entered into this area, some archaeologists say it could have been as early as 18,000 years ago.

The saline springs and fresh water marshes located along the Licking River, the present northeastern border of Nicholas County, were an attraction to herds of big game animals
