Navarro and Sexton were indicted by a Nicholas County Grand Jury March 17 on drug trafficking charges. Navarro was indicted on the charges of trafficking in a controlled substance (cocaine) and trafficking in marijuana more than eight ounces but less than five pounds. Sexton was indicted for two counts of trafficking in a controlled substance (cocaine) and two marijuana trafficking charges.
A Kentucky State Police Drug Enforcement Special Investigations Detective Anthony Anderson testified to members of the grand jury and was part of the team of law enforcement officials, including undercover agents with the Buffalo Trace Narcotics

Giardo, Lt. Governor of Kentucky. "This is the heart of Kentucky and the heart of Kentucky," Mongiardo said with a broad smile following the parade and after briefly speaking with and congratulating Frederick. "This is a great community to begin celebrating the Fourth of July."
Mongiardo joined the crowd in a thunderous standing ovation when local National Guard soldiers were handed honorary Kentucky Colonelships from Mongiardo on behalf of Governor Steve Beshear.
"I've witnessed patriotism from Carlisle and all across the state," Mongiardo said. "Neighbors protecting their neighbors... well that's as patriotic as it gets. These holdovers are very patriotic."
Mongiardo praised soldiers, event organizers and the Nicholas Countians who were in attendance to support the festival. He also singled out a 2006 graduate of NCHS.
"Walker Mattox is on our staff and he is a real wizard," Mongiardo said. "Walker is very adept at information technology and is our go to guy" on the governor's staff.
Mongiardo said he and Gov. Beshear would be working to bring more jobs to Nicholas County.
"And we want to bring jobs that fit well with the community," he said. "We are going to stop trying to force jobs that don't fit into communities and look closer at the community assets and see what jobs will be best and last longest for communities. We will be focusing a lot of our attention in the future on jobs and health-care."
Mongiardo said the Governor's staff would also be working closely in the future with individuals in the medical system.
"The drug problem has hit every single Kentucky county," he said. "I think we need to stop simply throwing drug addicts in jail. That's not the real solution to the long-term problem. We need to put criminals in jail but we need to solve the drug addiction problem. It's a difficult problem but we will be working on a way for addicts to get treatment."
