Amritsar is in the northwestern part of India in the state of Punjab. The population of the city is over 1.5 million.

It is home to the Golden Temple and is the spiritual and cultural center of the Sikh religion. The Sikh shrine attracts more visitors than does the Taj Mahal.

The city was founded in 1574, on land bought for 700 rupees. It is dominated by the history of the Sikhs and many of their sacred shrines are found in and around the city.

The central old city has narrow zigzag streets, mostly developed in the 17th and 18th century.

Amritsar lies on the main road from Delhi to Lahore in Pakistan. The city is also connected to most other major cities, such as New Delhi, Mumbai (Bombay) and Calcutta by an extensive network of rail system.

Amritsar has a climate typical of northwestern

India. In the winter season, November to March, temperatures range from about 61 degrees to about 39 degrees.

The city has an average literacy rate of 75 percent, higher than the national average of 59.5 percent.

The main, spoken language in Amritsar and in the surrounding villages is the standard Punjabi. Other languages spoken include English and Hindi.

The city has international airport with more than 150 flights weekly. By July of this year, it will be doubled in size with four jetways, a new parking area and much more.

Amritsar is also a major educational center with in-situations that are among India's best universities and colleges.
