CITY OF CARLISLE
ORDINANCE NO. 6506

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 51.01 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO GAS UTILITY DEPOSITS, TO CHANGE THE DEPOSIT FROM \$40.00 TO \$50.00 FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS FOR GAS SERVICE AND CHANGE THE DEPOSIT FROM \$125 TO \$150 FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS UTILIZING GAS FOR WATER HEATER AND/OR GAS COOKING RANGE EQUIPMENT.

Section 1. An Ordinance amending Section 51.01 (B)(2)(c) to read as follows:
