Cemetery vandal sentenced

A young Carlisle man charged with 65 counts of criminal mischief, in connection with acts of vandalism which occurred in the Carlisle Cemetery in December, failed to return felony indictments against Robinson and the felony charges were returned to misdemeanor criminal mischief charges. Robinson was sentenced to 90 days in jail for those charges last week and having previously served 45 days in jail following his arrest, he had the balance conditionally probated for a period of two years. Robinson was ordered to pay restitution of \$1,743 to the Carlisle Cemetery for damages incurred, and had paid \$800 in restitution before being ordered to the county's youth sector league, which is a Christian Church, where he allegedly slashed tires to a van and \$150 of
