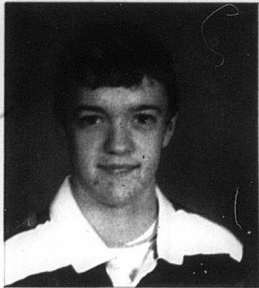

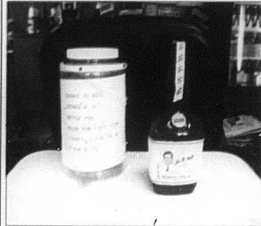

Field Trip

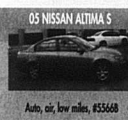
Young Kindergarten students took several field trips last week to downtown Carlisle, shown escorting one group is Patty Evans, instructional aid.

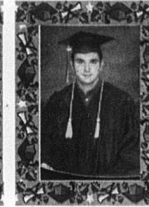

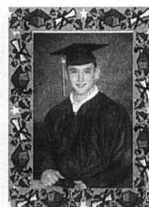

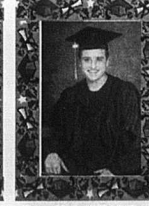
