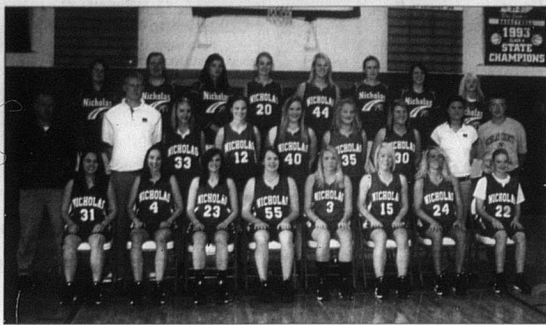

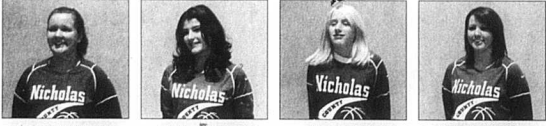

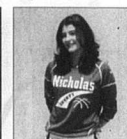
After graduation Kayla is becoming a nurse after graduation, but is undecided on the college she will attend.

After graduation Darius, who is a German Scholar, plans on attending Georgetown College, Come College or Morehead State University, where he said he will "try to further a career in baseball."



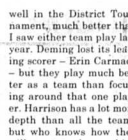
**Fabiula Hanauer**
