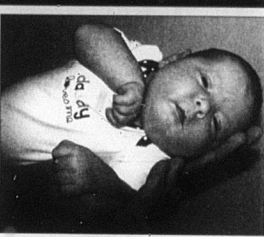

Andy Dudley inducted into Union College Hall of Fame

Barbourville, KY, 20 Nov 2008 - Winchester resident Ambrose "Andy" Dudley was inducted into the Union College Business and Professional Hall of Fame in Barbourville, Ky., on October 18.

The induction took place during Union's annual homecoming banquet and ceremony.

Dudley, a 1958 Union graduate, spent 36 years in the banking industry before retiring in 1997. His career was marked by leadership in both the civic and professional realms. Dudley was named Banker of the Year twice and led First National Bank of Carlisle through a period that saw 50 percent growth. His community involvement includes co-founding the first public library in Stanton, Ky., the Carmin Country Club in Carlisle, Ky., and work with the Rotary Club, Boy Scouts and Lion's Club. During his time as a Union College student, he worked with the city of Barbourville on rescue work during the devastating flood of 1955 and helped launch the college's first golf team.

Dudley and Betty, his wife of 56 years, live in Winchester.
