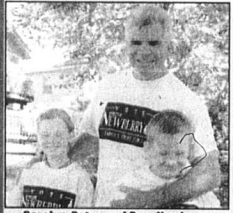

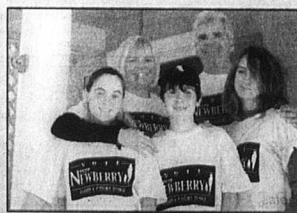

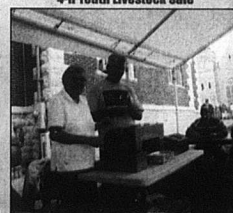

General functions include but are not limited to: Performing services under the supervision of a Registered Nurse or other appropriate professional staff; responsible for providing personal care services and other related health services ordered by a physician to patients, in their home(s), that are limited in their ability to perform activities of daily living; responsible for keeping records of services rendered and for reporting changes in needs and/or condition of the patient to the nurse. Currently we are looking for staff to work in Scott County but also cover Bourbon, Harrison and Nicholas County depending on the need of the agency; applicants may note on the application which county they are willing to work the majority of the time.  
Minimum starting salary: \$7.90-9.64/hour; salary negotiable with experience. Benefits and travel reimbursement.

Appropriate aide related experience may substitute for education requirements on a year-for-year basis for a maximum of four (4) years.
