A man accused of trying to burn Hall's Apartment building proclaimed his innocence last week on the same day his preliminary hearing was postponed in Nicholas County District Court.
Joy Trimble, 36, a former resident of Hall's Apartment, located on West Main Street, Carlisle, is charged with arson, first degree, seven counts of wanted endangerment, two counts of assault, third degree, and one count of criminal mischief, first degree.
Trimble and his co-defendant Phyllis J. Peterson, 20, who has the same charges, were arrested following a March 25 fire at Hall's Apartment Building.
Trimble said he arrived at the apartment complex that day to discover his apartment had been burned.
