## Hometown History

Back in 1775 salt was obtained by boiling water in kettles from the old salt well that was located a farm south of a church formerly owned by Isaac Allison. Saltwell became the name of the area located in Nicholas County.

The homes around Saltwell were built by people with average incomes. No fancy homes were built, just home made from logs until men took up carpentry and built new homes or remodeled the old ones. Many of the homes used straw for bedding to where now we use mattresses. George Mattox and Arthur Allison were high standing carpenters.

Saltwell Methodist Church was a main focus that drew an enormous crowd on Sunday's. People came a long ways from the hills, through hollows to attend church due to the fact of there being no other place to go.

The water for the homes came from the springs that were made by digging a hole in the ground and lining them with rocks. Back then children had plenty of chores to keep them busy with carrying in water for baths, and wood for cooking and heat. Now days the children don't do chores, they play video games, cell phones and computers. Looking back the old days were much better then they are now.
