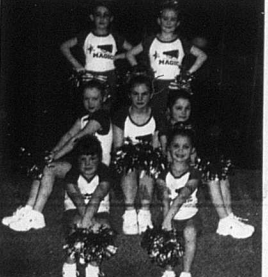
"Jade"
