Daily Shooting follow-up

Police training may have played role in fatal shooting

The investigation continues into the violent incident, which occurred Dec. 29 near midnight in the community of Headquarters, which left a Nicholas County woman shot to death by an officer of the law, and a community stunned.

Brenda Dalley, 55, of 2630 Headquarters Road, was shot to death by off duty Boone County Sheriff's Deputy Scott Hill, just before midnight on Dec. 29 on a farm she rented.

Law enforcement training may have played a key role in the fatal shooting.

"Our officers are trained to use whatever force is necessary to stop a threat," said Boone County Sheriff's Office Colonel Robert Reuthie. "Deputy Hill has been a good deputy for us for the past six years."

Reuthie said the Boone County Sheriff's Office does not make it mandatory for deputies to carry firearms while off duty.

"But it is strongly suggested that they do," he said.

Reuthie said Hill has not returned to work yet.

"He can't come back to work until he is cleared by a doctor and he won't be back on the road until the investigation is over."

Reuthie said he had spoken with Hill after the shooting and knew he was very distraught over the incident.

"It is extremely difficult to be in a position where you, take a life," Reuthie said. "We are in the business of protecting and saving lives, not taking life."

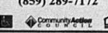
