Downtown construction project continues

An ongoing construction project in downtown Carlisle will continue for approximately three more weeks.

According to Carlisle Mayor Ronnie Clark, the project has been funded through the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet.

Workers with Bluegrass Electrical Consultants have been working along the corner of Broadway and Main Street and Locust and Main Street for the last month as part of a project that will provide a modern traffic lights to 15-foot deep hole, ap-

proximately three feet in diameter, had to be drilled at the corners of the downtown streets. The process has been slow and tedious.

Drilling at those depths has revealed plenty of surprises. Utility workers and city officials alike were dismayed when the large drill broke through a large vacant space at the corner of North Locust and Main Street three weeks ago.

"That was a real treat," Jackley Meyers, Bluegrass Electrical Consultant heavy equipment operator said with a smile when discussing the project Monday.
