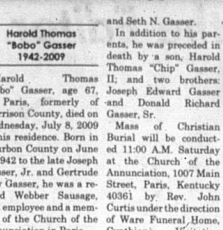
Harold Thomas "Bobo" Gasser 1942-2009

He was preceded in death by his father Ray Lewis Black.

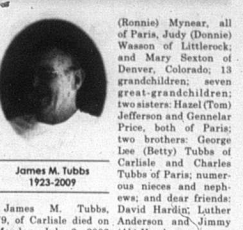
