Reward offered for missing Menfee woman

A \$4,000 reward has been offered in the missing persons case of Menfee County woman Nicole Van Zant. The 47-year-old, Menfee County single mother was last seen on Frenchburg Hill Monday Jan. 19, as she walked away from a car driven by her former boyfriend Josh Brown, according to investigators.

The Menfee County Sheriff's Department, acting on a tip about the possible whereabouts of Van Zant, searched various parts of the Red River by kayak on Tuesday, February 24th. Two four-man teams searched the area with the assistance of Red River Adventures. This area has been searched by aircraft and by foot but this allowed the teams to get a closer look at the river area.
