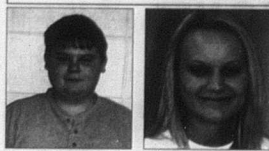

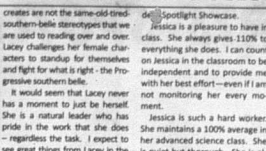
Thomas Akers

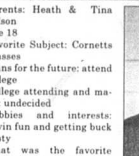
