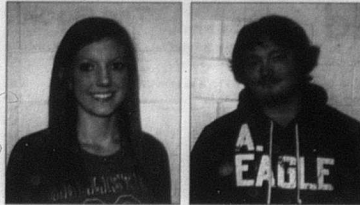


SENIOR FOCUS



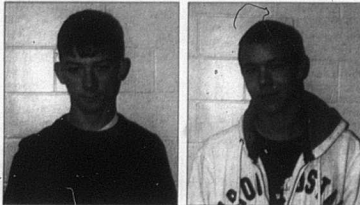

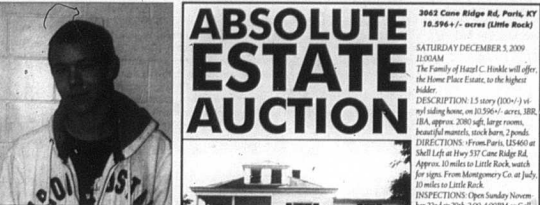
