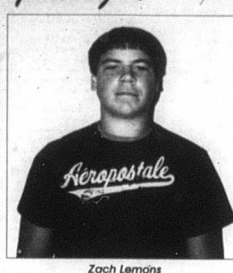

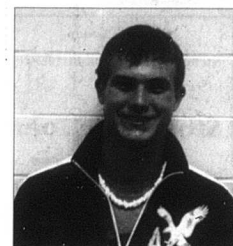
Sports Spotlight

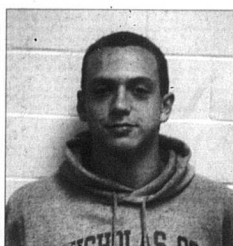

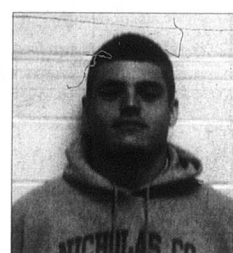

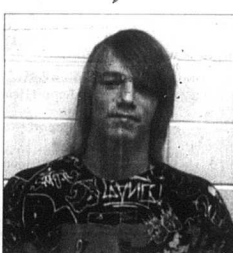
Caleb Pope Offense: Runs the ball extremely hard
