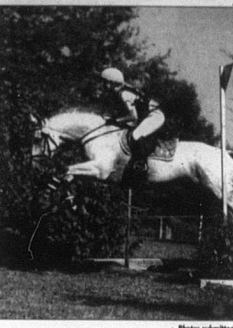

Carlisle native competes at nationals

Ashley (VanMeter) finished in the 300 qualified in last week's American Eventing Championships. Ashley and Mouse placed fourth in the US for their national title, trophies, an aggregate minimum purse of \$50,000 in cash and more than \$100,000 in prizes.

For their 4th place finish the pair brought home a portion of prize money and several gifts provided by this year's sponsors. The ABC's of the national championships for the equine sport of eventing, which includes three disciplines: dressage, cross-country jumping and stadium jumping held over the course of three days.

This is the first time the pair competed in the championships, held at Lamplight Squared in 2007 Center in Wayne-Hilms, from Sept. 10 through 13. In order to compete in eventing, with the assistance of her trainers, Ashley and Mouse Jennifer Joyce.
