PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the provisions of H.R. 464, enacted by the 107th Kentucky General Assembly, a public hearing has been set by the Nicholas County Public Library Board of Trustees for 2:00 p.m. on 10/24/07 at the Nicholas County Public Library. The purpose of the hearing is to inform the public that the Nicholas County Public Library is proposing the 5 percent increase in anticipated revenue for 2008. The tax rate increase is 4.94% increase in anticipated revenue. The tax rate for the preceding year was 4.80 cents with anticipated revenue of \$96,054. The compensating rate is 4.94 cents with anticipated revenue of \$105,120. The expected 2008 annual personal property is \$119,280. Increases for the 2008 budget year is needed due to the rising cost of books, library materials, technology, equipment and building maintenance. The Nicholas County General Assembly has required publication of this advertisement and the public is encouraged to attend hearing.
